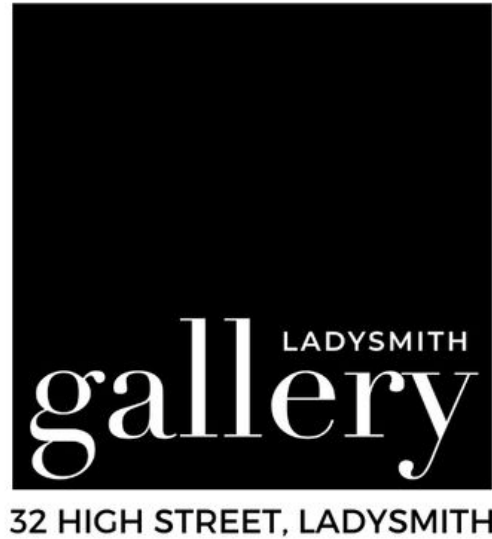

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Arts Council of Ladysmith invites youth under 19 to showcase their work in a professional gallery setting.

This show is for you if you're:

- studying art in school at the primary, intermediate, high school or homeschool
- taking recreational art classes

This opportunity allows emerging artists to:

- show your work in a professional art gallery
- have your artwork for sale
- build your portfolio
- gain confidence as an artist

Submission Instructions:

- Each artist can submit a maximum of 2 works of art
- Complete the 'Artwork Inventory Sheet' and the 'Youth Exhibition Labels For Artwork' sheet
- Attach the correct label on the back of the artwork securely
- All artworks must be for sale
- All artworks must be ready for installation. 2D artworks must be framed. Loose papers will not be accepted.
- Drop off artwork on intake day, please bring your inventory sheet
- You do not have to be a member of the ACLD to participate in the youth exhibition.

For Teachers:

- Please fill in the 'Group Name' on the inventory form and label - this is important if you are applying for multiple classes. Make sure each class has it's own inventory form
- Please make sure the correct inventory form is with the correct group of artwork at intake day.
- If you are not able to drop off on intake day, an earlier date of drop off can be arranged - contact gallery@ladysmitharts.ca



Exhibition Terms and Conditions

Installation:

Works must arrive at the gallery ready for installation with the correct label on the back (download label form). Please make sure an inventory sheet accompanies the artwork (download inventory form). Maximum of 2 works per artist. Eligible works are limited to under 36 inches in width, including any frames. The gallery will do their best to display all works submitted to the youth show, but due to space restrictions we may only be able to hang 1 work from the youth. Installations will be at the discretion of the art installation committee. Framing of 2D artworks is required. No loose papers will be accepted.

If you are submitting works on behalf of a whole class:

- Fill out the inventory sheet per class (one barcode will be assigned per class)
- Please download the label and inventory form prior to intake day and complete the necessary information.

Commission and Taxes:

For the Student Art Show, artists will receive 100% of the sales price in the event that their work sells in the show. **All artworks must be for sale.** For purchasers, PST (7%) will be charged on top of the sales price.

Payment to Artists:

Payment for sales during the youth show to the artist will be available the following month. Artists will be contacted through the information provided on the inventory sheet. Payouts that are not picked up within 3 months will be considered a donation to the ACLD.

For teachers submitting on behalf of students: Teachers will be contacted regarding students who have payments to pick up. It's the teachers responsibility to let their student(s) know about payments. Students will pick up payments at the Ladysmith Gallery.

Insurance & Liability:

Artists exhibiting their work at the ACLD gallery do so at their own risk. Works are not insured under the ACLD. The ACLD does use a building security system.

Works not picked up prior to the next show will be transported to our offices at 444 Parkhill Terrace for pickup, and the ACLD will not be held responsible for the care of the artwork.

The ACLD makes every effort to ensure that theft and damages do not occur; however, should any loss or damage occur, the artist/artisan understands and accepts the full risk of loss or damage to articles placed on consignment. Damaged items will be returned to the artisan.
